Andre "Hawk" Dawson, the NL Gold Glove Award winner in right field, led the ball club with 23 home runs. Hubie Brooks was the team leader with 100 runs batted in. He also hit 13 homers. Dawson was second with 91 runs driven in. Tim Wallach added 22 dingers and 81 RBI. Tim Raines hit for a "triple double": 30 doubles, 13 triples, and 11 home runs. He led the Expos in hits (184) and runs scored (115). As a team, they hit .247, 118 homers, and stole 169 bases...Bryn Smith (18-5 W/L record and 127 K's) was the pitching staff's top winner and strike out leader. Bill Gullickson won fourteen games while lefty Joe Hesketh won ten. Closer Jeff Reardon whiffed 67 batters and led the majors with 41 saves...The team actually held first place as late as June 28<sup>th</sup> with a 43-30 record. They fell to third place for the rest of the year July 26<sup>th</sup> and never got closer to the lead than four games as late as August 18<sup>th</sup>. Montreal WON the season series with first place Saint Louis, 11-7.
