"Les Expos" opened the season, April 1st, in Cincinnati, against the Reds...Just seven pitches into the new campaign, home plate umpire John McSherry collapsed from an apparent heart attack. Trainers and emergency personnel tended to the stricken arbiter who was quickly transported to hospital. Sadly, he passed away soon after leaving the ball park...Opening Day at Riverfront Stadium was postponed as well as the other "openers" scheduled that day...Team leaders: Henry Rodriguez (36 homers, 103 RBI); Moises Alou (21 home runs, 96 RBI). Mark Grudzielanek led the ball club with 201 hits while second baseman Mike Lansing tied the Expos shortstop with 99 runs scored for the year...Jeff Fassero led the pitching staff with 15 wins. He and Pedro Martinez (13-10 W/L record) led the staff with 222 K's each. "Oogie" Urbina (108 K's) won ten ball games and closer Mel Rojas struck out 92 batters...The Expos finished eight games behind NL East Champion, Atlanta, who won ten of thirteen games versus Montreal...As a team, the Expos hit .262 with 148 home runs while the pitching staff posted a 3.78 earned run average. That ERA placed them fourth in the National League.
