**Managerial records:** Lemon (34-40), Doby (37-50). Larry Doby replaced Bob Lemon as White Sox skipper, July 1<sup>st</sup>, to become the second African-American manager in major league history. (The Sox promptly lost his first game at Minnesota, 10-0.) Eric Soderholm led the ball club with 20 home runs. He was second on the team with 67 RBI. Lamar Johnson (eight home runs) topped the ball club with 72 runs batted in. He also led the Sox with 136 base hits. Jorge Orta and Chet Lemon both hit thirteen homers while Ralph Garr was the leader with 67 runs scored. Chicago hit .264 and 106 home runs for the season...Steve Stone was the pitching staff's top winner with 12 victories. Ken Kravec led the pitching corps with 154 strikeouts. Knuckleballer Wilbur Wood was 10-10 while Francisco Barrios (9-15) led the staff with nine complete games. The staff ERA was 4.21. The White Sox finished 20 ½ games behind first place Kansas City and WON the season series, 8-7. They were 8-2 versus Cleveland and 11-4 against Texas.
