Cub Paws: June 14th became a semi-historic day for the Reds Pete Rose after he singled in the first inning at Cincinnati off the Cubs Dave Roberts. Rose would get at least one hit in every game he played through August 1st, a 44-game hitting streak...The Cubbies would be in first place (or tied) for 31 scheduled games, the latest from May 24th through June 23rd. They held down second from June 24th through August 29th before slipping to third the remainder of the season...*Team leaders:* Dave Kingman (28 homers, 79 RBI); Billy Buckner (74 RBI); Ivan de Jesus (172 base hits, 104 runs scored); Rick Reuschel (14 wins, 9 complete games, and 115 strikeouts). Closer Bruce Sutter punched out 106 batters. The pitching staff ended the year eleventh in the N. L. in ERA (4.05)...In the batter's box, the Cubs topped the league in batting average (.264) and were eleventh with 72 home runs.
