The Reds were the first team to nail down a playoff spot with a 5-3 win over the Cubs, September 20th. They also became the first ball club to clinch a division championship with a win over the Dodgers, September 22nd. The division title was the second for the Redlegs in three years. The Giants (eventual World Champs) beat the Reds in the NLDS, 3-2. Cincinnati WON the first two games in San Francisco and then were swept at the Great American Ballpark. The Reds had won the season series, 4-3. Homer Bailey no-hit the Pirates in Pittsburgh, September 28th. He allowed TWO base runners--on an error and a walk--while striking out ten batters.

Jay Bruce led the Reds with 34 homers, 99 RBI, and 89 runs scored. Ryan Ludwick was next after hitting 26 dingers and driving in eighty. Todd Frazier blasted 19 home runs and knocked in sixty-seven. Joey Votto missed playing time following knee surgery. He played in 111 games and socked 14 homers with 56 RBI. Brandon Phillips topped the team in hits (163). The Reds hit .251 and 172 home runs for the year...Johnny Cueto led the pitching staff with 19 wins. He struck out 170 batters. Mat Latos was 14-4 and topped the staff with 185 K's. Bailey was 13-10 with 168 punch outs while Bronson Arroyo was a 12-game winner. Closer Aroldis Chapman whiffed 122 batters. The staff ERA was 3.34, second in the N.L. Their 56 saves led the league.
