Following their early dismissal from the post-season in 2011, the D-Backs came back to earth in 2012. But some fresh young faces would be adding some sock to the ball club. Jason Kubel led the team with 30 home runs and 90 RBI. Young star Paul Goldschmidt (20 homers, 82 RBI); Miguel Montero (15 homers, 88 RBI); and Aaron Hill (26 homers, 85 RBI, a team high 184 base hits) were other "big boppers" for Arizona. Justin Upton added 17 dingers and led the D-Backs with 107 runs scored. Chris Young's batting average fell by five more points from the year prior. He hit only 14 homers and drove in forty-one runs, way down from his usual output. Arizona hit .259 and 165 home runs...Wade Miley led the pitching staff with 16 wins while Ian Kennedy posted 15 victories and was tops in strikeouts with 187. Trevor Cahill was 13-12 for the year with 156 punch outs. Miley struck out 144 batters. Reliever David Hernandez had 98 strikeout victims. J. J. Putz whiffed sixty-five. The staff ended the year with a 3.93 ERA.
