Jody Gerut became the first player in major league history to hit a home run during the first at-bat in a brand new ball park. His homer sailed out of the Mets' new home, CITI FIELD, on April 13th off a pitch by Mike Pelfrey. The Padres won the game, 6-5...After Game 81, San Diego had settled into fourth place with a 35-46 record and 16 ½ games out of first...Adrian Gonzalez led the ball club in all the major batting categories: Homers (40), RBI (99), base hits (153), and runs scored (90). Kevin Kouzmanoff followed with 18 home runs and 88 RBI. For the year, the Padres hit .242 (last in the N. L.) and 141 homers (13th)...Kevin Correia led the pitching staff with twelve wins and 142 strikeouts. Jake Peavy and closer Heath Bell were next with six victories apiece. Bell was the league leader in saves. The staff ERA was 4.37 (10th in the league).
