Atlanta spent four days in April tied or alone in first of the NL East, but they would come no closer to the top again after July 3<sup>rd</sup> when they were in third place, two games out at 39-40. The Braves ended the year seven games behind division champ Philadelphia...Catcher Brian McCann was the team leader with 21 homers and 94 RBI. Shortstop Yunel Escobar--one who easily got into manager Bobby Cox's doghouse--led the team in base hits (158) and runs scored (89). Six other Braves walloped a combined total of 92 home runs. For the season, the Braves hit .263 as a team and 149 homers...The pitching staff finished with a sharp 3.57 ERA, good for third in the league. Six hurlers--including three starters and with all pitching at least 73 innings--ended the season with a personal ERA under 3.00. Two 15-game winners led the staff: Javier Vazquez and Derek Lowe. Jair Jurrjens won 14 games; Tommy Hanson eleven. Vazquez struck out 238 opponents; Jurrjens whiffed 152. Closer Rafael Soriano racked up a very impressive 102 K's...The Braves posted a 41-31 record versus Eastern Division ball clubs, including a 10-8 mark against the Phillies.
