Third baseman Mark Reynolds struck out 223 times (the most in the majors) but led the D-Backs with 44 homers, 102 RBI, and 98 runs scored. Justin Upton was next with 26 home runs, 86 RBI, 84 runs scored, and a team-high 158 base hits. Stephen Drew produced a "triple double": 29 doubles, 12 triples, and 12 homers. He drove in sixty-five. The team batting average was .253; they hit 173 home runs...Dan Haren led the pitching staff with 14 wins, 223 strikeouts, and three complete games.

Doug Davis and Max Scherzer both won nine ballgames. Scherzer whiffed 174 batters. The staff ERA was 4.42...Arizona finished 30-42 versus NL West opponents...

A. J. Hinch assumed managerial duties, May 8<sup>th</sup>. Managers' records: Melvin (12-17), Hinch (58-75).
