The Rangers finished ten games behind the A.L. West champion Royals. Texas WON their season series, 11-8...It turned out to be a year the ball club showed a lot of promise...and...a lot of turmoil as well: Josh Hamilton with more off-field/chronic injury problems, and Vicente Padilla's harsh and too frequent personality clashes with his teammates and management. (Padilla was cut loose by the team, August 8th)...Team leaders: Nelson Cruz (33 home runs, 76 RBI); Marlon Byrd (29 homers, 89 RBI). Ian Kinsler belted 31 homers and drove in eighty-six. Hank Blalock hit 25 dingers...Scott Feldman led the pitching staff with 17 wins (113 K's) while Kevin Millwood won thirteen games and led the staff with 123 strikeouts...As a team, the Rangers were second in the league with 224 home runs. They hit for a .260 average and were second in the A.L. with 149 stolen bases. The staff ended the year with an ERA at 4.38 and a save total of 45 (5th)...Hamilton ended the season with ten home runs and 54 runs batted in.
