Dave Winfield, who hit 21 homers and drove in 76 runs, reached **THREE** huge career milestones: 3,000 career hits, 500 doubles, and 450 home runs. Kent Hrbek led the ball club in homers with twenty-five; Kirby Puckett (22 home runs) led the team with 89 RBI, 184 hits, and 89 runs scored. Hrbek drove in eighty-three...Number One starter Kevin Tapani was the leader of the pitching staff with 12 wins and 150 strikeouts. Lefty Jim Deshaies and fellow starter Willie Banks both won eleven contests. **Team stats:** .264 batting average, 121 home runs, and a 4.71 ERA...The Twins ended the season 23 games behind the first place White Sox who also won the season series, 10-3...Puckett was the All Star Game MVP at Camden Yards with a solo home run and run-scoring double. He was two for three in the game. The American League beat the National League, 9-3.
