The A's finished at the bottom of the AL West due to many factors, primarily the loss of key players from prior solid ball clubs, and, of course, injuries. Dave Stewart had been lost to free agency, Walt Weiss and Rickey Henderson were traded, Carney Lansford retired, and Mark McGwire played in only 27 games. The pitching staff was a disaster, mainly due to four starting pitchers finishing with earned run averages over 5.00. A's chuckers posted a league-worst ERA of 4.90. Bobby Witt won fourteen ball games and struck out 131 batters to lead the staff. Bob Welch won only nine times. Former Number One draft pick Todd Van Poppel was a bust. He won six games, walked 62, and punched out 47...Oakland hit .254 and 158 home runs as a team. Ruben Sierra was the leader with 22 homers and 101 RBI. Brent Gates, sixth in Rookie of the Year voting, topped the A's with 155 base hits. Sierra and Rickey Henderson ultimately tied for the team lead in runs scored (77)...Oakland's record in '93 was the worst since 1982.
