In the first week of the season, the Brewers fell to fifth place (April 11<sup>th</sup>) and never did move above that position the remainder of the schedule. At the mid-point, their record was 33-48 placing them in seventh and 14 ½ games out of first. They finished 26 games in back of AL East Champion Toronto... As a team, Milwaukee hit .258 for the season and 125 home runs. Slugger Greg Vaughn led the ball club in three categories: homers (30), RBI (97), and runs scored (97). Darryl Hamilton topped the team with 161 base hits. Robin Yount, 37, wrapped up his 20-years in the big leagues with eight home runs and 51 RBI. He spent his entire career with the Brewers and retired with a .285 batting average; 251 homers; 3,142 base hits; and 271 stolen bases in 2,856 games. John Jaha followed Vaughn with 19 dingers; Kevin Reimer stroked thirteen. B. J. Surhoff was second to Vaughn in RBI (79)...Cal Eldred was the pitching staff's biggest winner (16) and posted the most strikeouts (180). He completed eight games as well. Both Jaime Navarro and Ricky Bones won eleven ball games. The staff ERA was 4.45, tenth in the American League. They completed the most games (26).
