The Mariners completed their 17th season in Seattle twelve games in back of the AL West Champion White Sox. The Chisox won their season series, 9-4. At the All Star break, the M's were an even 44-44 and in fourth place only two games behind the division leaders. They jumped into third place, September 22nd, eight-and-a-half out but lost five of their last nine games... Ken Griffey, Jr. finished FIFTH in A. L. MVP voting but turned in an awfully remarkable season: 45 home runs, 109 RBI, 180 base hits, and 113 runs scored, all the highest on the team. He DID NOT lead the majors or the league, surprisingly, in ANY of those categories. Jay Buhner was next with 27 homers, 98 RBI, and 90 runs scored. The M's finished eleventh in the league in batting average (.260) and fifth with 161 home runs... One of the true stars in the game, Randy Johnson, posted a 19-8 won/loss record and set a new team mark with 308 strikeouts. The "Big Unit" led the majors in strikeouts, as well as strikeouts per nine innings pitched (10.856) and fewest hits allowed per nine innings (6.521). Johnson completed ten. Three other starters won a total of 44 games. Staff ERA: 4.20 (4th A. L.).
