Big Mo Vaughn clobbered 29 home runs, drove home 101, and scored 86 times to be the Bosox leading hitter. His 160 base hits were second to Mike Greenwell's one hundred seventy. Greenwell and free-agent signee, Andre Dawson, 38, both hit thirteen homers. John Valentin added eleven dingers and led the team with 40 doubles. A .264 team batting average placed them eighth in the American League; they finished the year thirteenth with 114 home runs, rather low for the Red Stockings. However, they had the highest total of doubles in the league [319]...The pitching [3.77 ERA] was fairly pretty good. Danny Darwin posted 15 wins as the staff leader while Roger Clemens and Frank Viola both won eleven times. Clemens punched out 160 batters for the most strikeouts; Darwin compiled 130 K's...The Red Sox enjoyed a 23-day ride in first place as late as July 23rd [a tie] with a 55-43 record. When the calendar turned to September, like autumn leaves the Bosox had fallen all the way to fifth place in the AL East, 69-62, and 6 ½ games out of first. Boston ended the season fifteen games in back of division champ Toronto. During regular season games versus the ball clubs which finished above them in the standings, the Red Sox won twenty-two and dropped thirty.
