American League MVP Frank Thomas produced a monster season for the AL West Champion White Sox: 41 home runs, 128 RBI, 174 base hits, 106 runs scored, and 36 doubles. Robin Ventura was next after blasting 22 homers and driving home 94 runs. Catcher Ron Karkovice added twenty more jacks. Lance Johnson topped the A.L. with 14 triples. He stroked 168 base hits for the year. The Sox hit .265 (seventh in the league) and 162 home runs which placed them fourth at season's end...A.L. Cy Young Award winner Jack McDowell posted a record of 22-10 which included a team high ten complete games and four shutouts. He struck out 158 batters. McDowell tied two National League pitchers (John Burkett and Tom Glavine) for the most wins in the majors. Alex Fernandez was 18-9 in wins/losses and led the pitching staff with 169 K's. Southpaw Wilson Alvarez was 15-8 with 155 strikeouts and 122 bases on balls. Jason Bere went 12-5 and struck out 129 batters. Closer Roberto Hernandez whiffed 71 batters. The Sox led the A.L. in ERA (3.70) and were second in saves (48)...Chicago finished eight games in front of the second place Texas Rangers but were beaten in the ALCS in six games by the eventual World Champion Blue Jays. The two ball clubs had split their regular season series, 6-6...Bo Jackson was the league's Comeback Player of the Year while skipper Gene Lamont was the winner of the Manager of the Year Award in the junior circuit..."Bo" Jackson's birth name is Vincent Edward.
