The '93 Yankees, a highly competitive ball club, missed the playoffs, and would not again until 2008. They spent a total of 19 days of the schedule TIED for first place--the latest day September 5th--but were never alone atop the AL East. After 81 games, they were 46-35, in second place, and only two games out of first...New York led the league in batting average (.279) and finished second with 178 home runs. Top dog was Danny Tartabull with his 31 homers, 102 RBI, and 87 runs scored. Wade Boggs scored 83 times and topped the ball club with 169 base hits. Catcher Mike Stanley blasted 26 round-trippers while Paul O'Neill added twenty more. Don Mattingly slugged 17 homers, drove home eighty-six, and picked up his eighth Gold Glove Award...The pitching staff ended the year with a 4.35 ERA placing them seventh in the league. By far, the staff kingpin was lefty Jimmy Key who went 18-6 in wins/losses, struck out 173 batters, completed four games, and put up two shutouts. Jim Abbott followed with eleven victories and Scott Kamieniecki added ten. Melido Perez (6-14 W/L) was second on the staff with 148 K's.
