Bob Geren was relieved of managerial duties, June 9th, with a record of 27-36. He was replaced by Bob Melvin (47-52) on an interim basis for the remainder of the season. Melvin's contract was later extended to manage the ball club for 2012... Josh Willingham was the team leader with 29 home runs and 98 RBI. Catcher Kurt Suzuki followed with 14 dingers. DH Hideki Matsui was second with 72 runs batted in. He popped 12 homers. "Coco" Crisp's 140 base hits were tops on the team while he tied Willingham for the lead in runs scored (69)... "Gio" Gonzalez led the pitching staff with a 16-12 W/L record and 197 strikeouts. Trevor Cahill was the only other double-digit winner with a 12-14 record and 147 K's... The A's hit .244 and 114 home runs for the season... The pitching staff was third in the AL with a 3.71 ERA... Oakland finished 22 games behind Western Division champion, Texas, and 12 games in back of the second place Angels. Oakland won six of nineteen regular season games versus the Rangers, eleven of nineteen contests against Anaheim.
