From 2004 to 2011, the "Jays" wore predominantly black and gray with an altered blue jay bird logo design. This was known as the "Black on White" uniform. They returned to their classic "Blue Jay" bird logo and blue as the primary color the following season... The Jays were led by Jose Bautista with 43 homers, 103 RBI, 155 hits, and 105 runs scored. He was also the major league home run champ. Adam Lind popped 26 home runs while J. P. Arencibia hit 23 round-trippers. The latter set a new team record for home runs by a catcher in a season. For the year, the Jays hit .249 and 186 home runs...Ricky Romero led the pitching staff with 15 wins while striking out 178 batters. Brandon Morrow (11 wins) struck out 203 opposing hitters. Four other pitchers followed with six wins apiece. The staff ERA was 4.32...Under first-year manager John Farrell, the Jays would finish 16 games behind the division champion Yankees and nine in back of third place Boston.
