Carlos Pena was the Cubbies' home run leader with 28 for the season. Aramis Ramirez popped 26 jacks and led the ball club in RBI (93). Alfonso Soriano was second on the team with 88 RBI and matched Ramirez's home run total. Twenty-one year-old prodigy at shortstop, Starlin Castro, had team highs in hits (207), runs scored (91), and doubles (36). Ramirez collected 173 base hits. Chicago was seventh in the N.L. in batting (.256) and tenth in home runs (148)...

Ryan Dempster and Matt Garza both won ten ball games to lead the pitching staff. Garza's 197 strikeouts were the team high. Dempster racked up 191 K's. Carlos Zambrano posted a 9-7 record while Jeff Samardzija went 8-4 out of the bullpen which included 87 punch outs. Closer Carlos Marmol struck out ninety-nine. The staff ended the season fourteenth in the league with a 4.33 ERA...With new manager Mike Quade at the controls, the Cubs ended April in fourth place with a 12-14 record. They would get no closer to first in the NL Central than 2 ½ games on May 4<sup>th</sup>. At the All Star break, Quade's ball club was 37-55 and in fifth place twelve games from the top spot...Beloved former team captain and broadcaster, Ron Santo, passed away in December of 2010 as a result of complications from cancer and diabetes.
