Joey Votto led the Reds with 103 RBI, 185 base hits, 101 runs scored, and 40 doubles. He also hit 29 home runs. Second baseman Brandon Phillips socked 18 dingers and drove in eighty-two while Jay Bruce (97 RBI) slugged 32 home runs--the latter best on the ball club. Utility outfielder Chris Heisey added 18 homers and drove in 50 runs. The Redlegs hit .256 and 183 home runs (2nd in the league) for the season...Starter Mike Leake topped the pitching staff with 12 victories and 118 strikeouts. Three other hurlers, Bronson Arroyo, Johnny Cueto, and "Homer" Bailey all won nine games. Edinson Volquez was 5-7 with 104 K's. Tall lefthander, Aroldis Chapman, 23, overpowered 71 strikeout victims. Reds' hurlers finished twelfth in the N.L. with a 4.16 ERA...Cincinnati finished 17 games behind NL Central Division champion Milwaukee. The two teams split their season series, 8-8...The ball club spent 25 days of the schedule in first place as late as May 18th with a half-game lead and 25-18 record. By Game 81, they were 41-40 and in fourth place 3 ½ games out of first.
