During the off-season, GM Omar Minaya and manager Jerry Manuel were let go. A new era for the Mets began with former Oakland A's GM Sandy Alderson being hired for the Mets' General Manager's job and Terry Collins as field manager...After knee surgery, Carlos Beltran came back to lead the team with 15 homers and 66 RBI. Jose Reyes led the National League in batting average--after sitting out the final game--and the major leagues with 16 triples. He topped the ball club with 181 base hits and 101 runs scored. Captain David Wright socked 14 home runs and drove home sixty-one. Jason Bay popped 12 dingers. The Mets hit .264 (2nd in the N.L.) and 108 homers... Dillon Gee led the hurlers with 13 wins while Chris Capuano was tops with 168 K's. Both Capuano and Jon Niese were 11-game winners. The staff ERA was 4.19.
