The D-Backs rebounded from a last place finish in 2010 to win 29 more games in 2011 and finish the year as NL West Division champs for the fifth time. They were knocked out of the playoffs by the Brewers in the NLDS, three games to two...Justin Upton was the leader with 31 homers, 88 RBI, 171 hits, and 105 runs scored. Chris Young was next with 20 home runs and 71 runs batted in. Ryan Roberts clubbed 19 jacks and Kelly Johnson added eighteen along with Miguel Montero. The D-Backs hit for the same average as they did in 2010 (.250) but they hit eight fewer homers...Ian Kennedy led the pitching staff with a spectacular 21-4 W/L record and 198 K's. Daniel Hudson was 16-12 and struck out 169 batters. Joe Saunders won twelve games and Josh Collmenter won ten times. The staff ERA (3.80) was lower by over one run from 2010.
