New General Manager Alex Anthopoulos declared before the season his ball club was in a "re-building mode". At the season's mid-point, the Jays were 41-40 and in fourth place just eight games out of the lead. They would get no closer than that to the AL East lead but it was an interesting year to say the least...Jose Bautista hit a team record (and major league leading) 54 home runs. As a team, the Jays slugged 257 round-trippers (most in the majors) and hit .248 for the season. Bautista led the Jays with 124 runs batted in and 109 runs scored. He was followed by Vernon Wells's 31 homers and Adam Lind's 23 dingers. Wells led the team in hits (161)...Lefty Brett Cecil led the pitching staff in wins (15) while fire-balling Brandon Morrow was a ten-game winner and topped the staff in strikeouts (178). Ricky Romero (174 K's) won fourteen games and Shawn Marcum added thirteen. Closer Kevin Gregg whiffed 58 batters. The staff was tenth in the A.L. with a 4.22 ERA...The Blue Jays or "Jays" (as they were frequently referred to) wore predominately black and gray as team colors--their "Black on White" uniform.
