Dallas Braden pitched a PERFECT GAME against the Rays in Oakland, May 9th. The A's won, 4-0. Present was Dallas's grandmother who reared him after his mother passed away. It was the nineteenth perfect game in major league history. Landon Powell was the catcher. Braden struck out six batters...Kevin Kouzmanoff led the ball club with 16 homers. He and Kurt Suzuki topped the A's with 71 RBI apiece. Suzuki and Jack Cust both hit 13 dingers. Cust knocked in 52 runs. Daric Barton was the team leader in hits (152) and runs scored (79). As a team, the A's hit .256 and 109 home runs...Trevor Cahill led the pitching staff with 18 wins while "Gio" Gonzalez led the staff in punch outs (171). Gonzalez won fifteen ball games. Along with his "perfecto" Braden completed four other contests. He was 11-14 for the year. Lefthanded reliever Craig Breslow whiffed 71 batters. The A's staff had the lowest ERA in the A.L. (3.56) and allowed the fewest runs (626)...Oakland ended the year nine games in back of division champion, Texas, who won the season series, 10-9
