Trey Hillman, once considered the best person who could turn around the floundering Royals on the field was dismissed as manager, May 13<sup>th</sup>, with a record of 12-23. Former Milwaukee skipper Ned Yost guided the team to a 55-72 record the rest of the way. The Royals missed the playoffs for the 25<sup>th</sup> straight year...Yuniesky Betancourt and Jose Guillen tied for the team lead with 16 home runs while Betancourt and Billy Butler both led the ball club with 78 RBI. Butler topped the team in hits (189) and runs scored (77). The Royals .274 batting average was second in the A.L. and their 121 home runs twelfth...Bruce Chen led the pitching staff with 12 victories. Zack Greinke posted a 10-14 record and was the staff leader in strikeouts (181). Kyle Davies won eight ball games. The staff ERA was 4.97 (14<sup>th</sup> in the A.L.).
