At the end of May, the Sox were 20-30 and seemingly going nowhere. The ball club had been as much as fifteen games below .500 and 15 ½ out of first place in May. They went 18-9 in June which left them in third place only nine games out of the lead in the AL Central Division. After being 41-44 at the All Star break, the White Sox got as close as 6 ½ games of the lead on August 11<sup>th</sup>, but never could break through to challenge for the division title...

Number One starter Mark Buehrle led the pitching staff with a 16-8 record and 126 strikeouts. Kip Wells, who started twenty games, was a ten-game winner. Spot starter Sean Lowe was next with nine victories while "Rocky" Biddle and James Baldwin both won seven games. Closer Keith Foulke ended the year with 75 K's. The staff ERA was 4.55...First baseman Paul Konerko cracked 32 homers and right behind was rightfielder Magglio Ordonez with thirty-one. Ordonez led the Sox with 113 RBI and 181 base hits; Konerko followed with 99 runs batted in and 164 base hits. Ray Durham hit for a "triple double" with 42 doubles, 10 triples, and 20 home runs. He led the Sox with 104 runs scored. Jose Valentin smacked 28 dingers and Carlos Lee added 24 more. The White Sox hit .268 and 214 home runs for the year--the latter figure was second in the American League...Chicago would end the season eight games behind division champion Cleveland but would win the season series, 10-9.
