The Redlegs never spent a day in first place but they DID post a ten-game winning streak from July 2nd through July 15th opposite an 11-game losing skein from June 14th through June 24th...The elder of The Brothers Boone, Bret, led the ball club with 24 home runs and 95 RBI. Barry Larkin and Dmitri Young tied for the team lead in base hits (166) while Larkin topped the Reds in runs scored (93). Cincinnati hit .262 for the season along with 138 homers...Pete Harnisch's fourteen victories led the pitching staff. He struck out 157 batters. Brett Tomko was the staff leader in strikeouts (162) and second with thirteen wins. The Reds hurlers finished the year 10th in the N. L. with a 4.44 ERA.
