**White Sox right fielder Magglio Ordonez had a fabulous season at the plate and in the field: 29 homers, 99 RBI, 192 base hits, 95 runs scored, and 46 doubles. He had seven outfield assists but there weren't many base runners who challenged his very strong and accurate throwing arm. (During his at bats, the public address system would blare "Oh wee Oh, Maagg Lee Oh!" in an effort to get the fans pumped up for a SOX rally.) Frank Thomas led the team with 42 round-trippers. He was second with 105 RBI. Carlos Lee slammed 31 homers while knocking in 113 runs and scoring 100 times, the latter two figures team highs. Jose Valentin added 28 dingers and 74 runs batted in...Starter Esteban Loaiza was a 21-game winner and led the pitching staff with 207 strikeouts. Bartolo Colon (15-13) wracked up 173 K's and led the staff with nine complete games. Mark Buehrle was 14-14 for the season. Closer Tom Gordon had 91 strikeout victims and lefty Damaso Marte whiffed eighty-seven...As a team, the White Sox hit .263, 220 home runs and finished just four games behind division champion Minnesota. The White Sox were 9-10 versus the Twins during the regular season...The pitching staff finished with a 4.17 ERA...Skipper Jerry Manuel was fired after the season with a 500-471 record. He had just completed his sixth year on the bench.**
