This team was the subject of a book: *The Worst Team Money Could Buy*. (Yep. This ball club was no where near your Daddy's '86 Mets.) Bobby Bonilla (at 29 million dollars), Bret Saberhagen and Willie Randolph were off-season acquisitions which didn't pan out in many ways--Bonilla (who returned home to NYC) in particular--didn't hit to his normal standards. Saberhagen and Randolph were injured for most of the year. Howard Johnson and closer John Franco battled injuries as well. Late season pick up Jeff Kent (from Toronto for David Cone) made few friends in the Mets' clubhouse with his no-sense, humorless approach to his new team. The turmoil in the clubhouse beget a lot of losing...Bonilla (70 RBI) led the Mets with 19 homers. Eddie Murray (16 homers) was the leader with 93 RBI and 144 hits. Daryl Boston added 11 homers...Sid Fernandez was the pitching staff's top winner with 14 victories while David Cone (13-7 W/L record) led the staff with 214 strikeouts before he was dealt. "Doc" Gooden was 10-13 with 145 K's and nothing close to his former dominating talent...For the year, the Mets hit .235 and 93 home runs...The staff's ERA (3.66) was tenth in the N.L.
