For 2001, the Devil Rays donned new uniform colors: Green and Black, including a "sleeveless" vest-style jersey. The "rainbow gradient" neon look was gone. Manager Larry Rothschild was fired, April 17<sup>th</sup>, with a record of 4-10 after a 10-0 loss to Boston. Hal McRae, Rothschild's bench coach, guided the ball club to a 58-90 mark for the rest of the year. Team leaders: Greg Vaughn (24 homers, 82 RBI, 74 runs scored); Steve Cox (12 home runs, 51 RBI); and Ben Grieve (11 dingers, 72 RBI, 72 runs and a team-leading 143 base hits). Fred McGriff added 19 home runs and 61 RBI before his trade to the Cubs, July 27<sup>th</sup>...Tanyon Sturtze was the only double digit winner (11) on the pitching staff. Ryan Rupe led the staff in strikeouts with 123 K's. Sturtze struck out 110 batters. Paul Wilson was 8-9 with 119 punch outs. Closer Esteban Yan struck out 64 batters...Tampa Bay scored the fewest runs (672) and hit the fewest homers (121) in the American League...The D-Rays drew just over 1.2 million to Tropicana Field...Tampa Bay finished 34 games behind the division champion Yankees who won the season series, 13-6. The D-Rays won only ONE season series, 6-1, against the Twins along with being on the positive side in inter-league contests, 10-8. As a team, Tampa Bay hit for a .258 batting average. The staff ERA was 4.94 and allowed 887 runs.
