Ace Pedro Martinez compiled a "season for the ages" in winning the National League Cy Young Award: a major league-best 1.90 ERA and thirteen complete games. He struck out 305 batters (11.374 per nine innings)--both marks second in the majors. Among his seventeen victories were four shutouts. Martinez became the first righthanded pitcher since 1912 (Walter Johnson) to strike out at least 300 batters with an ERA under 2.00. Teammate Carlos Perez won twelve games, eight of which were complete games, including five shutouts. The staff ERA was 4.14 (seventh in the NL)... At the plate, Expos batters hit .258 and 172 home runs. Rondell White's 28 homers topped the team. Other leaders: Henry Rodriguez (83 RBI), Mark Grudzielanek (177 base hits), and Mike Lansing (86 runs scored). Rodriguez hit 26 "big flies." Their 339 doubles led the league. Phenom Vladimir Guerrero joined the ball club for good and contributed eleven dingers.
