Rightfielder Harold Baines has reached the peak of his game with 22 home runs and a team high 113 runs batted in, 198 hits, and 86 runs scored. Carlton Fisk led the team in home runs (37) and was second to Baines after knocking in 107 runs. Ron Kittle added 26 dingers. First baseman Greg Walker slammed 24 homers, drove home ninety-two, and led the team with 38 doubles. For the season, the Sox hit .253 and 146 homers...Britt Burns was at the head of the pitching staff with 18 wins, eight complete games, and four shutouts. Forty-year-old Tom Seaver finished the year 16-11 with six complete games and 134 K's. Floyd Bannister was 10-14 and led the staff in strikeouts (198). Spot-starter Gene Nelson was an even 10-10 in wins and losses. White Sox hurlers were the league leaders with 1,023 strikeouts and seventh with a 4.07 ERA...The Sox finished six games behind the AL West Division champion Kansas City Royals. K. C. took the season series, 8-5...On a side note, the A's Jose Canseco became the 27th player to hit a home run OVER the old Comiskey Park roof on September 30th.
