Thirty-six-year-old Mike Piazza received a long and heart-felt standing ovation on his last day in a Mets uniform and completed his time in the Big Apple with 19 HR and 62 RBI...The ballclub hit .258 and 175 homers for the season paced by Cliff Floyd's 34 jacks. He finished second to twenty-two-year-old David Wright's 102 runs batted in after tallying 98. Wright was second with 27 home runs and led the team with 42 doubles. Jose Reyes was the major league leader in triples (17) and the N. L. leader in stolen bases. The Mets swiped the most bases in the league (153)...The pitching staff turned in a dazzling 3.76 ERA, the N. L.'s third-best. Pedro Martinez won 15 and lost 8 during the season and tied for fifth in the majors in strikeouts (208). He was fourth in ERA. Tom Glavine ended the year an even 13-13; Kris Benson won 10 ballgames...The Mets reached no more than eight games over .500 on August 26th...Versus NL East foes they were 38-36.
