Redleg Ramblings: Managers' records: Miley (27-43), Narron (46-46). Dave Miley was fired after a loss, June 20th, with the team in last place of the NL Central and 18 ½ games out of first. Jerry Narron, the bench coach, moved into the manager's office. They were still last at the All Star break, 21 games out...Felipe Lopez (23 HR, 85 RBI, 34 2B), was the only Red selected for the All Star squad. Adam Dunn was the team leader with 40 HR, 101 RBI, 35 2B, and 107 runs scored. Ken Griffey, Jr., 35, whacked 35 jacks and drove home 92. The Reds (.261 team BA), hit the most homers (222), doubles (335), and scored the most runs (820) in the N. L....Aaron Harang led the pitching staff with 11 wins and 163 strikeouts. Brandon Claussen won 10 ballgames. The staff had the worst ERA (5.15) and most runs allowed (889).
