The Yankees 11th consecutive season as a playoff participant..."The Bombers" finished the campaign in a dead tie with Boston for the top spot of the AL East, but claimed the crown after winning ten of nineteen regular season games versus the Red Sox...New York completed the year second in the league in both home runs (229) and team BA (.276). AL MVP Alex Rodriguez's 48 homers, 124 runs scored, .610 slugging percentage, and 1.031 OPS were the league's best. He played in all 162 games and led the Yanks with 130 RBI. Gary Sheffield hit 34 jacks to go with 123 RBI while Jason Giambi slugged 32 home runs and Hideki Matsui added 23 homers and 116 RBI. Derek Jeter (19 HR) topped the ballclub with 202 base hits...Randy Johnson, fourth in the league with 211 strikeouts, led the pitching staff in wins (17). Mike Mussina was next after posting 13 victories and 142 K's. Closer Mariano Rivera put up a miniscule 0.868 WHIP. The staff's ERA, 4.52, placed them ninth in the A.L...New York and the Anaheim Angels split the first four games of the ALDS before the Angels won the decisive Game Five, 5-3, in Anaheim to advance in the playoffs. Jason Giambi went 8 for 19 (.421) in the series; Jeter, who popped two home runs, hit .333 and drove in five of the Yankees 20 runs scored.
