Willie "Stretch" McCovey concluded his eventual Hall of Fame career at forty-two and 19th season wearing a Giants uniform. The former Rookie of the Year (1959) and N. L. MVP (1969) ended his time in the big leagues with 521 home runs (tied for 20th in MLB history with Ted Williams and Frank Thomas), 2,211 base hits, 1,555 RBI, and six All Star Game appearances. He took home a .515 career slugging percentage and .889 OPS. In 1980, he participated in 48 games (27 at first base) with one homer and 16 RBI. Jack Clark's 22 jacks and 82 RBI were the most on the ballclub. Darrell Evans was next with 20 home runs and 78 RBI. The team was twelfth in the league with a .244 BA and ninth with 80 homers...The pitching staff completed the year with a very respectable 3.46 ERA, fourth in the league. Vida Blue won 14 games and struck out 129 to be the staff leader. Ed Whitson was the only other double-digit winner with 11 victories...The Giants were shutout 16 times and 37-52 against NL West competitors.
