One had to wonder if maybe "The Big Red Machine" was throttling-up again after their 8-0 start to the season. They won 11 of their first 12 games and finished April 13-6 and in second place after holding down first up until the 29th. At the All Star break, the team was third at 41-38 but only 4 ½ games from the NL West lead. The Reds spent eight more days during the year in sole possession/tied for first (the last as late as August 16th) but fell to third on the 23rd for the rest of the schedule to finish up 23-17 from that date but never out of striking distance of the leaders. They posted a 17-19 record versus the Astros and Dodgers who ended the season first and second, respectively...As a team, the Redlegs hit .262 (5th in the league) and 113 home runs (6th). The muscle came from George Foster and his team-leading 25 jacks while Johnny Bench knocked 24 out of the park. Foster had the most RBI (93) followed by Ken Griffey, Sr.'s 85 on the strength of the latter's 28 2B, 10 3B, and 13 HR. Speedy Dave Collins ended the year third in the league and fourth in the majors in stolen bases...The pitching staff showed no dramatic change from the '79 season but Tom Seaver won six less ballgames to finish 10-8 in W/L. Mike LaCoss, Charlie Leibrandt, and spot-starter Mario Soto all won 10 contests. Frank Pastore garnered the most of the group (13 wins). The fire-balling Soto, 23, whiffed 182 opposing batters. Pastore, 22, was next with 110 K's. The staff ERA (3.85) was ninth in the league.
