Managers' Records: Gomez (38-52), Amalfitano (26-46). Preston Gomez didn't last the season. He was fired July 23rd and replaced by Joey Amalfitano as interim manager, a role Amalfitano filled in 1979...Team leaders: Jerry Martin (23 HR, 73 RBI); Bill Buckner (41 2B, 68 RBI, 187 hits, 69 runs); Lynn McGlothen (12 wins); Rick Reuschel (140 K's). Bruce Sutter was the N. L. save leader. The staff ERA was 3.89 (11th) and second in the league with 923 strikeouts. The Cubbies hit .251 (10th) and 107 HR (7th). The ballclub plopped into last place, July 15th, and remained there for the rest of the year. They won 38 and lost 52 to division opponents. They beat the Mets 10 of 18 games, the Reds 7 of 12.
