The A's roster is now void of any player from the great World Series champions in the earlier part of the decade. Owner Charlie Finley attempted to sell the franchise to buyers from New Orleans but the city of Oakland stepped up and refused to terminate Finley's lease to play in the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum...The team NEVER spent a single day at .500 or over from start to finish. They were in last place of the AL West at the All Star Break with a horrid 25-69 record, 30 ½ games out of first. Surprisingly, the longest losing streak the A's dealt with was eight games (three times). Oakland won ONE season series, 8-5, over Seattle. They were 6-6 versus Milwaukee...The A's scraped the bottom of the American League in most team stats: batting average (.239), runs scored (573), and base hits (1,276). They ended the year thirteenth with 108 homers. The team's home run leader was Jeff Newman (22). Dave Revering held the team lead with 77 RBI, 136 base hits, and 63 runs scored. He was second with 19 jacks. Wayne Gross popped fourteen. Rickey Henderson, 20, who would later become the major leagues' greatest base-stealer, did not figure in Rookie of the Year voting. He made his big league debut, June 24th, against the Rangers, produced two hits in four at bats, and stole his first career bag. His first of FOUR separate career tours in an A's uniform was completed with one homer, 26 RBI, and 33 stolen bases in 89 games...The pitching staff's ERA (4.75) placed them thirteenth in the league while they allowed the most bases on balls in the majors (654). Rick Langford topped the staff with twelve wins, 101 strikeouts, and fourteen complete games. Steve McCatty won eleven ballgames. The staff allowed 860 runs.
