Managers' records: Herman (64-82); Runnels (8-8). Red Sox brass made the managerial change after a win at Cleveland, September 7<sup>th</sup>. First base coach Pete Runnels was named interim manager prior to a weekend series against the Yankees at Fenway two days later. The lowly Yanks swept the Bosox all three games...Boston was 3-10 at April's end and 37-52, in last place, 22 games out at the All Star break...*Team Leaders*: Fan favorite Tony Conigliaro (28 HR, 93 RBI, .817 OPS); Carl Yastrzemski (165 base hits); and Joe Foy (97 runs scored). Twenty-two-year-old George Scott bashed 27 homers and drove home 90. Jose Santiago won 12 games; Jim Lonborg struck out 131...As a team, the Red Sox hit .240 and 145 home runs. By today's standards, the staff's 3.92 ERA would be very good. In 1966, it was the worst in the American League after they allowed 637 earned runs and a total of 731.
