White Sox pitching was outstanding: the most complete game shutouts (19) in the major leagues and the second lowest ERA (2.68 to the Dodgers 2.62). They finished atop the A. L. with the fewest home runs allowed (101), second fewest bases on balls allowed (403), and the least number of base hits allowed (1,229). Gary Peters was the league leader with his 1.98 ERA and 0.982 WHIP. He was second in both categories behind the Dodgers Sandy Koufax in the big leagues. Tommy John tied eight other pitchers in the majors with the most shutouts (5). He led Chicago's staff with 14 wins and 138 K's...On the flip side, White Sox batters produced the lowest team BA in the major leagues (.231) and the second fewest homers (87). However, they won the stolen base title (153), nine more than the high flyin' St. Louis Cardinals. A. L. Rookie of the Year, twenty-three-year-old Tommie Agee, led the ballclub with 22 jacks, 86 RBI, 172 base hits, and 98 runs scored. Johnny Romano was next with 15 home runs. Don Buford ended the year third in the majors in stolen bases...Chicago was 21-33 versus the teams who finished above them in the final standings.
