The shortened season of 60 games in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic brought an opportunity for new General Manager Ben Cherington and new skipper Derek Shelton to see what they really have for a ball club. It wasn't a disaster if not promising. Even though Starling Marte was now playing in other pastures and with Josh Bell never getting untracked at the plate, the new Pirate brain trust DID get a peak at the team's top prospect, Ke'Bryan Hayes, and some young arms to build a semblance of a good pitching staff. Reliever Richard Rodriguez had the most wins on the staff (3) while the Bucs five primary starters posted a horrific combined record of 8-23. Of that group, Trevor Williams and Chad Kuhl both won two ball games apiece. The pitching corp's ERA of 4.68 doesn't look so bad after one takes a look at some of the inflated individual earned run averages. Joe Musgrove's 55 strikeouts were the most among the hurlers; Williams was next with 49 K's. Jameson Taillon was unavailable as he recovered from forearm, hand, and throwing elbow surgeries...Pirates batters finished 13<sup>th</sup> in the National League with a .220 team batting average and 59 home runs. Colin Moran put up 10 jacks to lead the team; Josh Bell clubbed eight; and the trio of Adam Frazier, Bryan Reynolds, and Gregory Polanco all knocked out seven round-trippers. Moran and Frazier both drove home 23 runs; Bell and the injury-prone Polanco both accounted for 22 RBI.
