Practically from the start of the shortened regular season caused by COVID-19 pandemic protocols, the Cardinals were one of the teams prominently impacted by the virus. Two players tested positive in the season's first week resulting in the first game of a series versus the Brewers to be postponed. With more positive infections identified on the team the next day, the remainder of that series and the following one against Detroit were also postponed. In early August, series between the Cards and Cubs as well as against the Pirates were moved to later dates. By the time the Pittsburgh series came up on the schedule, a total of 17 members of the ball club had tested positive. (In the end, the Cardinals would play two less games of a 60-game schedule since they were among eight teams to automatically qualify for the playoffs. The two canceled games weren't required to be played to determine seeding.)...In the Wild Card round, the Redbirds drew the Padres for a best-of-three match-up. St. Louis won Game One, 7-4, on the strength of 13 hits. Game Two went to the Padres, 11-9, with the two opponents combining for 25 hits. San Diego utilized NINE pitchers to blank the Cards, 4-0, in the decisive Game Three. "Yadi" Molina hit .462 (6 for 13) while Paul Goldschmidt popped two home runs...Tyler O'Neill, 25, tied Brad Miller for the team lead in homers (7). Tommy Edman collected the most RBI (27); Miller and Paul DeJong followed with 25 apiece. O'Neill also was awarded his first Gold Glove...Adam Wainwright, 38, was the pitching staff's biggest winner with five and strikeout leader with 54. Starter Jack Flaherty and reliever Genesis Cabrera both won four ballgames. The staff ERA (3.90) ranked them fourth in the N. L.
