Birds of a Feather: The 60-game season as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic may not have been a good barometer, but the Orioles hit .258 as a team (a 12-point improvement over 2019) and it appeared some of the youngsters heavily counted upon to step up and contribute as regulars were close at hand. Ryan Mountcastle, 23, hit well over .300 to go with his 5 home runs and 23 RBI in 35 games. Cedric Mullins, 25, played like the centerfield job was his to lose while Austin Hays performed as if he now belonged on the big club. Anthony Santander, 25, hit 11 jacks and knocked in 32 runs. Renato Nunez, 26, popped 12 homers and collected 31 RBI. Rio Ruiz added 9 dingers and 32 runs batted in...The pitching staff showed some improvement lifting their ERA from last in 2019 to ninth in the A. L. after the short season. Two relievers, Travis Lakins and Thomas Eshelman posted the most wins (3); the promising John Means racked-up the most strikeouts (42). He allowed only seven walks. Keegan Akin, 25, joined the O's after undergoing Tommy John surgery in 2019. The former 2nd-round draft pick in 2016 whiffed 35 opponents and walked 10...The ball club played .500 ball through August 23rd, but dropped off to a 10-16 mark in September.
