The much-anticipated hiring of former Yankee field boss Joe Girardi, whose magic in leading the Bronx Bombers to six post-season appearances in ten years and a World Series title, did not rub off on the Phillies. Girardi frustratingly tried to find some combination for an effective bullpen, but his machinations never panned out. It was the most noticeable deficiency of the ball club. The schedule was also a nemesis to the team: COVID-19 protocol problems with opposing "nines" as well as the Phils destroyed any semblance of continuity. Still, if the Phillies had beaten Tampa Bay on the regular season's final day, they could have slipped into the playoffs along with losses by both the Giants and Brewers. It wasn't to be... *Team Leaders:* Bryce Harper (13 HR), Didi Gregorius (40 RBI), Aaron Nola five wins and 96 strikeouts. Free-agent-to-be J. T. Realmuto contributed 11 jacks and 34 RBI. Three others cracked ten home runs apiece. Newcomer Zack Wheeler won four ballgames and struck out 53 batters. Zach Eflin (4 wins) had 70 K's... Regular season team stats: .257 BA (5<sup>th</sup>), 82 HR (6<sup>th</sup>), 5.14 ERA (14<sup>th</sup>).
