White Sox batters hit at a .261 clip (2nd in the A. L.) and 96 home runs (#1 in the league) for the season as the ball club climbed into serious contention for future playoff appearances. With all second place teams automatically qualifying for the post-season in an expanded format due to COVID-19 protocols, the Sox were seeded against Oakland in a best-of-three Wild Card series. Chicago won Game One, but dropped the next two to be eliminated. Tim Anderson hit .643 in the three games (9 for 14) while American League MVP Jose Abreu hit .286 and a homer. Yasmani Grandal popped two jacks against A's pitching...The 33-year-old Abreu smacked 19 home runs during the abbreviated campaign and led the big leagues with 60 RBI. He was tops in the A. L. with his 76 base hits and .617 slugging percentage. Eloy Jimenez, 23, clobbered 14 home runs and drove home 41 mates. Much-heralded Luis Robert, 22, finished second in Rookie of the Year voting and captured a Gold Glove. In the batter's box, Robert contributed 11 homers and 31 RBI...Rejuvenated lefty Dallas Keuchel, 32, was added to the pitching staff as a free agent and tied Matt Foster for the most wins on the team (6). He wound up fifth in Cy Young balloting. Number One starter Lucas Giolito, 25, went 4-3 in W/L and led the staff with 97 strikeouts...Centered around their young talent, White Sox fans got a good look at what the future might hold on the South Side. It appears to be very promising.
