The Rangers finally got to play with fans in the stands for the first full 81-game schedule in their new Globe Life Field. The attendance was just over 2.1 million, the best in the American League. (The ballpark actually opened in 2020 and hosted the NLDS, NLCS, and World Series during the COVID-19 pandemic.) The team reached a .500 record one day, April 7th (3-3); was as many as 36 games out of first, September 23rd; and battled through a 12-game losing streak, July10-25...The season saw beloved Joey Gallo traded to the Yankees and pitcher Kyle Gibson swapped to the Phillies, but some young guns with bright futures arrived on the scene. The best appeared to be rookie Adolis Garcia who hit 31 baseballs out of the park, drove in 90 runs, and ended the year with a .741 OPS. Former Ray Nate Lowe was a solid addition with 18 jacks, .771 OPS, and his welcome leadership at 25 years old...The pitching staff had veteran Jordan Lyles, 30, as its top hurler. He won ten games and struck out 146 opposing hitters.
