Mets Notes: 17-34 record, 5th place (first half of strike-shortened season); 24-28, 4th (second half). Overall, finished in 5th place of NL East...Dave Kingman's 22 homers were the most on the team and tied five others in the big leagues. He led the Mets with 59 RBI. "Mookie" Wilson tied three others in the majors in triples (8)...Starter Pat Zachry and reliever Neil Allen topped the pitching staff with 7 wins each. Allen also tied for 5th in the majors in saves...Fan favorite "Rusty" Staub returned for the second time as a free agent in December 1980. He had been traded to the Mets by the Expos in 1972 before being moved to Detroit in 1975...Iron man relief pitcher, well-known flake, and kinesiologist, Mike Marshall, 38, ended his career with the Mets following his release in October. He had been originally signed as an amateur free agent by the Phillies in 1960 but chose to attend Michigan State University...In the '81 major league draft, the Mets selected Roger Clemens in the 12th round but he turned down a contract. Lenny Dykstra was chosen in the 13th round and later became a vital cog on the '86 Mets World Championship team.
