The Nats 18<sup>th</sup> season in D. C. was as nightmarish as they go. Matters weren't helped any when the team's best player, Juan Soto, and first baseman Josh Bell (who was enjoying a very good season after a bad 2021) were both shipped to San Diego at the trade deadline to aid the Padres pennant run. This team won TEN fewer games than the previous year, the third time they had lost 100-plus while stationed in Washington...As a team, the Nats were seventh in the N. L. in batting average (.249), but last in home runs (136). Soto wound up the team leader with 21 homers while Nelson Cruz, 41, led the ballclub with 64 RBI. He swatted 10 home runs. Before Bell departed, he had hit 14 round-trippers. Lane Thomas was a bright spot with 17 jacks and 52 RBI in 146 games, showing flashes of outfield fielding brilliance...Twenty-four-year old Josiah Gray had the most wins on the pitching staff (7), despite an ERA over 5.00, and the most strikeouts (154). The saga of Stephen Strasburg continues. He pitched in one game the entire year (a start, June 9<sup>th</sup>) and was raked for seven runs in 4.2 innings before returning once more to the injured list with a rib injury. Later moved to the 60-day I. L., he was unavailable the remainder of the season.
